## Scrip Tuition Incentive Program

### New for 2010-11 School Year!

We are excited to announce a new program called **Tuition\$ave**, a Scrip Tuition Incentive Program. The goal of this program is to reduce your tuition while raising money for Abiding Savior Lutheran School! As you know, scrip gift cards can be used to make everyday purchases with no additional cost to you.

**For the 2010-11 school year, as a special incentive, 50% of the profit generated by your scrip purchases will be credited towards your tuition expense for the following school year.**

Here are some program highlights:

- Anyone can purchase scrip, and, if they wish, can designate their share of the profit as a tuition credit towards a specific ASLS student (Early Childhood-8<sup>th</sup> Grade) or towards our tuition assistance program
- Tuition credits will be given for purchases of “cash and carry” gift cards in the school office, by the Scrip order form, online at [www.shopwithscrip.com](http://www.shopwithscrip.com), or by using Schnuck’s eScrip program
- All scrip card purchases made between August 16, 2010 and May 31, 2011 will be eligible
- In the case of a Pre-Kindergarten or eighth-grade family with no younger children at ASLS, a check will be issued instead of a tuition credit at the end of the school year

Families wishing to participate will need to complete an enrollment form, which is attached. Your account will be setup and tracking will begin right away. For tracking purposes, each participating family will receive a report of their accumulated purchases mid-year. The final tuition credit amount will be reported in mid-June.

The savings could really add up! For example, a purchase of a \$100 Dierbergs Card (they donate 5%) would result in a rebate of \$5. The tuition credit of 50% would be \$2.50. If you made this purchase each week of the school year, you could end up with a tuition credit of \$100! Imagine adding purchases of gift cards for the restaurants who visit regularly and more! There is no limit on the amount you can accumulate.

Programs like this have been very successful at other private schools and have proven to raise profits for the school beyond the standard scrip program.
